It is important to us that you understand the process before you place an order. After you have read this, please sign and return by fax or post. We shall silver plate the engraved copper plate that you have provided for us.

This means:

- The plate will be turned up at the edges to be made into a dish, so any text near these edges may well be turned up as well. **Please see our website for images.**
- The engraving on the plate will be in reverse (wrong-reading) ie: a mirror image of your invitation. For a plate to have the text right-reading, a new plate will have to be engraved. There might be scratches or blemishes on the reverse of plate from the die-stamping machine. This is perfectly normal but these **WILL** be noticeable when the silver plating is done – If you would like us to try and remove these, there will be an extra cost for which we can quote you. **Some customers stick some baize when feet are not needed, which will hide any blemish on the underside.**
- The plate is not only of sentimental, but also monetary value, so if posting to us, **Special Delivery should be used.**
